

Crowds expected to travel “Back to the Future” at free movie-inspired event

Turn the time circuits on and check the flux capacitor, “Back to the Future” will be making its way to Redlands this weekend.

Thousands are expected to enter the alternate time zone Saturday, as Superbad Action Figures will be host to more than 50 props from the sci-fi adventure film, including a set of DeLorean’s and a dozen other movie cars, at the area’s first-ever “Back to the Future Day.”

Spearheaded by DeLorean International, a Highland-based group aimed at promoting DeLorean awareness—“Back to the Future Day” is set from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. at Superbad Action Figures, 1235 Indiana Court Suite 111, in Redlands.

Many of the props on display at the free Sept. 14 event are contributions from the collection of the group’s founder, Bryan Boudreau. Among the items in his collection include the original A-car from part one of “Back to the Future,” Doc’s lab coat along with Marty’s 2015 letterman’s jacket and Nike’s will also be on display.

“We’re bringing a little bit of Hollywood to the Inland Empire,” Boudreau said. “It’s definitely going to be a pop-culture film fans dream.”

Other movie cars expected to be on display include the original screen car from John Carpenter’s “Christine,” the Ecto-1 Ghostbusters car, Jurassic Park Jeeps #33, #04 and #05, an original Comic-Con Kitt replica from “Knight Rider” and the 2008 Shelby Mustang, the Mystery Machine from “Scooby Doo” and the Star Wars Z-wing car from the Star Wars 501st legion.

The 501st legion are the official movie-accurate Star Wars costuming group, and will also be on hand in full costume and armor to meet fans.

But movie props aren’t the only things that will be attracting sci-fi film fans.

Special effects supervisor Kevin Pike is scheduled for the event for autograph signings and photo opportunities.

Pike created the first DeLorean time machine for “Back to the Future” and his other special effect works include Jaws 1 & 2, Star Wars Return of the Jedi, Jurassic Park films, Indiana Jones and the Temple of Doom, Star Trek films, Ed Wood, Fight Club, Fantastic Four, Close Encounters of the Third Kind and The Incredible Hulk television show.

Figures will be selling a limited edition replica Back to the Future DeLorean time machine collectors car. The car comes with full light up and sound features with added hover conversion. The car is \$75 and can be signed by Pike, organizers said.
